Correspondence study: students automatically receive a next course when you complete & return current lessons to us.

Independent study: please write on plain paper to request your next course when you complete current course.

Group study: please send a letter describing your group and a letter from the chaplain informing us of facility approval to mail quantities of literature.

To enroll for the first time, please complete 1-5:

1. Choose one of two options for course study:

a. *correspondence study* – you **mail** lessons for feedback

b. *independent study* – **no mailing** of lessons

We request that you commit to entirely finish each course you begin; we want the materials to be used. We send 1 course at a time.

Your first course will be *What Is a Biblical Christian?* Upon completion, we normally ask you to take several more basic courses before any others.
