Purpose of the Internship

Chapel Library is a ministry of Mount Zion Bible Church of Pensacola, Florida, which is dedicated to promoting Christ-centered, grace-exalting literature worldwide without charge. Our purpose is to honor the Lord Jesus Christ by building up His churches and by calling the lost to repentance and faith in Him. Therefore, the internship program of Chapel Library is designed to help young men grow in their walk with Christ by working in a worldwide Christian ministry, which may include learning web/eBooks skills, partaking in evangelistic outreaches, fellowshiping with and learning from families of Mount Zion Bible Church, gaining life skills, and maturing in biblical manhood. The program is neither a reform school nor a program for wayward boys, but an opportunity for young men with a heart for Christ to experience firsthand the way a Christian ministry functions and the way our Lord provides for His people.

Who May Apply: Any converted young man between the ages of 18 and 25, who has the approval and recommendation of his parents and church leader(s), may apply for the Chapel Library internship program.

Terms and Conditions: Interns are expected to work hard, performing whatever responsibilities are assigned to them with a humble, God-honoring attitude. Interns will be exposed to rich historical Christianity from a Reformed, Baptist perspective. Therefore, interns will be under the sound weekly preaching of the Word of God. Interns will also be required to attend the morning staff prayer meetings, Monday through Friday. There will be a place of residency provided for the interns, which is next to the MZ/CL facility. The intern coordinator will be responsible for intern scheduling, daily tasks, and accountability. All interns are encouraged to maintain daily communion with the Lord; therefore, a set time will be allotted for that purpose. All interns will uphold our house rules. There will be a stipend granted to the interns for personal needs and groceries. The internship will be terminated and the intern sent home at his own expense upon any proven inappropriate behavior.
